# Circles of Dialogue

The Patricia and Phillip Frost Museum of Science will host a series of small-group, participatory discussion sessions, called 'Circles of Dialogue', related to our current exhibition, *Race: Are We So Different?* Circles of Dialogue create safe spaces for groups visiting RACE to engage in meaningful dialogue as a way of continuing the learning opportunities offered by the exhibition. Each Circle of Dialogue event runs from 6:00PM-9:00PM and includes one hour in the RACE exhibition followed by a two-hour group dialogue led by trained facilitators, intended to deepen understanding of the exhibit through real and honest conversations about the wealth of diversity in our community.

These dates are available on a first-come/first-serve basis, and must be booked at least two weeks in advance. Maximum group size is 25. Please note, Circles of Dialogue are intended for youth and adults, ages 15 and over. The cost per group is \$200 for this special program. Full payment is due at the time of booking. The booking may be cancelled with a full refund up to 7 days prior to the date of the event. No refunds will be issued for cancellations within 7 days of the booked event.
